Category	Maximum Points
<b>Relevance to AAUW Mission Statement and Educational Funds Program Goals</b> How well do the goals of the project tie in with the goals of AAUW and the branch?	20
<b>Impact of Project</b> How many individuals will be impacted? How great is the need for the program?	15
<b>Feasibility of Project</b> Is the project reasonable? Are there other resources in place to ensure its completion?	20
<b>Timeliness of Project</b> Will the project be completed within one year of the award?	10
<b>Appropriate Use of Funds</b> Will materials be used as intended and consumed during the life of the project? Does the overall budget of the program reflect prudent use of the funds? Does the organization need this grant to conduct the project?	15
<b>Evaluation Method</b> Has the program developed a valid method to determine the success of the project?	10
<b>Effect of Project and Results on Image of North Harris County branch AAUW</b> Will NHC AAUW benefit from association with this project and organization? Will the recipient do everything possible to publicize our contribution?	10
<b>Total Points</b>	<b>100</b>
